ACADEMIC

A very good evening to the very august gathering. Today I **Pragya Agarwal** and I **Sanidhya Vyas** stand before you to present the annual report.

We begin with felicitation of academic achievers in the class 12 and 10 CBSE exams 2017.

In the class12 CBSE board exams **BHUMI SETH** topped the science stream with an aggregate score of 95.2 %.**BHUMI SETH** also emerged topper in English with 97% and in economics with 98%.

KARTAVI PATEL secured the second position in the science stream with 94.4% aggregate. She also topped mathematics with 99% and physics with 97%.

NIDHI JARIWALA with 94.2% aggregate bagged the third position in the science stream. She was also the subject topper for biology with 95% marks.

Our other subject toppers are:

TAEEB BANDWALA scored a highest of 99% in chemistry and 98% in Computer Science. **TAEEB** was also among the 0.1% top scorers in chemistry at the national level for which he was awarded the certificate of merit.

TAEEB BANDWALA was also declared eligible for the Arun Lal Fellowship sponsored by PRL, Ahmedabad for the second consecutive year.

TANMAY SHISHODIYA topped mathematics with 99%.

In the commerce stream **SNEH AGARWAL** topped with 88.8%. She also scored the highest of 94% in informatics practices and 83% in accountancy.
