Academics:

So, we start first with the academics. E.I.S was successful in achieving **100 % result** in the board examination of **std X & XII conducted by C.B.S.E.**

For Std X Board Examination, **25** students were awarded **0.1 merit certificate by C.B.S.E at national level for securing A1 grades in all the five subjects.**

For Std XII Board Examination too, our students came out with flying colors. We proudly proclaim that **100%** of our students for both **Science and Commerce stream** passed with **first class.**

In Science stream:
