Skill Enhancement Sessions

We at EIS believe in the thought 'Education is a lifelong process'. Hence, the different workshops, seminars, webinars and conferences attended by the students, Principal Mm and teachers help in this lifelong process.

Our school has been associated with Global Citizenship Foundation to help bring about a positive change in the society and the world. In continuation of this effort, we have now taken up Global Citizenship Education, which is a strategic area of UNESCO's Education Sector programme. It aims to instil in learners the values, attitudes and behaviours that support responsible global citizenship: creativity, innovation, commitment to peace, and most importantly, kindness and compassion.

As a prerequisite, 579 students and 34 teachers of EIS successfully completed a course on Global Citizenship Education conducted by The UNESCO MGIEP, a research institute focused on promoting social and emotional learning, innovative digital pedagogies and empowering youth.

The workshops attended by the students include career counselling, Personality development, Leadership development by M R PAI foundation and Language skills. Students of Class 12 got an opportunity to attend the AMNS integrated internship where they learnt about technical, legal and financial aspects of an organization.

Ted-Ed club offers students the opportunity to discover, explore, and present their big ideas in the form of short, Ted style talks.

An orientation program was organised by teachers and counsellors for parents of LKG, UKG and Grade 1 students. The counsellor focused on 3 essential needs of a child: Affection, Appreciation and Sense of achievement.
