AMNSIS students continue the trend of achieving 100 % qualitative results in both class XII and X-CBSE examinations.

In class 12 science the highest score of 96.2% was secured by Shobhit Goel. He also scored the highest marks of 98 in Mathematics and Computer Science, and in English and physics with 95.

Rahul Saraf stood second with 93 %, scoring highest in Computer Science with 98 and Physics with 95.

Takshil Ronak Shah stood third with 92.8 % scoring highest in Chemistry with 96.

In class 12 commerce, Prajakta Namjoshi stood first with 95.8%. She scored highest in Business Studies with 98 marks, and in Information Practices with 95.

- The school won the prestigious title of 'National Champions' in the INCA National Map Quiz 2023. Soumitro Dey, Swastik Dasgupta and Aritro Dey of class 10 claimed the national championship after winning the top position in Gujarat Branch Round.
- Aditya Kakadia, Harkeerat Singh, Praful Malik, Ansh Rajpal, Prem Moorjani, Shivansh More, Shlok Darji, Puneet Sisendra P. and Pruthvish Naik of grade 12, participated in the 10th edition of an international competition called Beamline for Schools, organised by European Organization for Nuclear Research, the world's largest particle physics laboratory, CERN, Geneva.
- 14 students bagged first, second and third prizes from amongst 72 participants from Thailand, USA, Nepal, Bangladesh, Japan and India in the 18th edition of Desh Raag Bharat Sanskriti Yatra organised in Thailand by Hindustan Art and Music Society in collaboration with Florida University, USA and Nrityadham Kala Samiti. Kashish Ketan Doshi came to limelight for winning a scholarship for her prize winning solo classical dance, first in Malaysia and then in Thailand. Diva Denis Thakkar won the first position in solo classical dance while Devinaa Bhatia won the same prize in junior category in solo folk dance. Mrigank Kothari and Aniket Agarwal bagged the first position in duet folk dance in the same category.
- International Astronomical Search Collaboration trains students to detect asteroids around the earth. Diganth BV of class 10 and Nandan Koppad of grade 9 discovered an asteroid and named it after the school calling it AIS0001.
- AMNSIS TEDEd club students connected with TEDEd students from Royal Woods Academy Nicosia Cyprus. During an hour long online meeting students talked about the two countries' history, culture, art, music popular sports political and education systems.

- Radha Gopal Vekariya of Grade 5 was awarded as the youngest and the most enthusiastic speaker at the Dramatic Adaptation Competition organised at IIT Mumbai by Indian Debating League and Burlington. She was among the top 8 students out of over 1500 students to qualify for the semifinals. In the debate competition organised in collaboration with IIT Delhi, Paavika Grover, Aahna Sheth, Yashvardhan Koul, Dev Bharodiya and Tanishq Pitliya won the state round to form the state team.
- Students have been actively participating in various quizzes organized by ZEE Mindwars. Soumitro Dey of class X got the Second rank, among 4000 students from around the country, in the National Academic Championship 2023. Along with Soumitro, Mauli Padshah of Class V and Ishit Prajapati of Grade 8 have won positions in many other quizzes too. In the Spell Bee Competition, about 135 students participated at the school level, out of who 8 reached the state level and 2 have reached the cluster level.
- Three students from the school have etched their names in the India Book of Records. Meera Karthik Vasan, a five year old created 50 different paintings using 12 techniques in just two days, Krishnav Agarwal of Grade 5 made 50 paper boxes in a record time of 30 minutes and Adrika Singh of Grade 1 solved a 104 pieces India Map Jigsaw Puzzle in a record time of 8 minutes and 38 seconds.
- Khush Devnani of grade 2 secured the first position in Tangram and Shapes Puzzle, and the second runner up position, out of more than 500 participants, in a national level mental math competition in Mumbai.

State and city level achievements:

- Khushi Oza of class 10 bagged the second position, while Mudrika Oza bagged the third in solo performance in Bharatnatyam in All India 9th cultural national dance contest and festival named Nityambhara in Ahmedabad.

- Arnav Gupta and Dhruv Bhandari of grade 11 and Manveer Kaur of grade 9 secured the second runner up position out of 101 participants, in a highly competitive coding competition, PyWars: Unleash your Coding Craft, organised by Fountainhead School, Surat.
- Kashvi Singh of Grade 8 bagged the second position in solo singing in an interschool event Kala Kruti organised by Fountainhead School, Surat
- The students have been regularly participating in the Mock United Nations Debates organised by various schools and organisations. MUN is a simulation that imitates the procedures of the United Nations finding solutions for real-world problems, done through an academic simulation of the United Nations procedure. It consists of negotiation, discussion, and lively debates, which is the cornerstone of UN activity and aims to educate students about current events, international relations, diplomacy, and the United Nations agenda. Along with knowledge of the world we live in, participants also develop skills including public speaking, presentation, persuasion, situation analysis, research, and critical thinking.

This year at GD Goenka MUN, Sneha Desai of grade XI was invited to act as the vice chair of Lok Sabha while Harsha Nahar of grade 9 won high commendation. Harshita Nahar and Suhani Banthia of grade 9 won verbal mention for their excellent performance.

At MUN KI AWAAZ' organised by Tapti Valley School, Pratham Tekriwal, Devanshi Mittal, Het Mehta and Aman Kumar, all from grade 10 won the best delegate, high commendation and special mention awards respectively.

- Aatmaja Patel of Grade 7 won a gold medal as a school topper in National Astronomy Challenge.
- Two teams participated in the Regional Level CBSE Science Exhibition at Baroda with their projects on AI Voice Assistant, and Stock Price Prediction.

The students also participate in various Olympiads, debates, workshops, exhibitions and other events that not only help them showcase their skills and talents but also align their skills with those needed in today's time and also keeps them updated with the career and other trends today.

Other engagements:

- Samarth Rathi of grade 7 has emerged a young budding writer and has a book titled Magitech Unveiled published under his name. Congratulations and way to go Samarth.
- In Confluence 2023 many schools from across Gujarat participated in the various competitions namely Debate, Create and Assemble, Pitch Your Business Idea, Advertisement creation, Designtastic and Musartecho, Season 1-The Battle of Bands. In keeping with the school's tradition, our students participated in all the competitions for learning but did not compete for positions.
- Out of 52 students who took the Bruhad Gujarat Sanskruti Parishad's Bharatnatyam Exam, 5 students got distinction, while 45 passed with 1st division.
- The knowledge fests this year saw students from all classes demonstrate their learning, projects, and skills in a diverse range of subjects learnt in activity clubs, Thursday Activities and Special Activity classes. The AI Voice Assistant project, along with many others, was highly appreciated by the guests.
- The learning fiesta for students of classes 6 to 8 enabled them to showcase their creativity and knowledge in science and math projects, oratory skills in declamation, and presentation skills in teach me a concept activity.
- A two-day Leadership Camp, in collaboration with M.R. Pai Foundation and Forum for Free Enterprises, Mumbai trained the students of Grade 11 in soft skills, goal setting habits and team building to facilitate life skills.
- AMNSIS and Think Young organised a three days workshop to train students of grades 11 and 12 on the basics of entrepreneurship and planning a business. At the end of their training, students created their own business ideas and pitched their plan before some entrepreneurs from Surat who were impressed with the students' ideas..
- A rock and pop music workshop by Mr. Vishal Parikh and his team to inform the students about Trinity
 College, London music exams and share information about various styles, genres, time signature and other
 techniques of music.
- Career counselling session for students of classes 10 to 12 by a faculty of BML Munjhal University and by Mr Rahul Pradhan.

- 11 international and 30 national universities participated in the education fair organized by the school. Students from classes 9-12, and parents interacted with the university representatives about various courses, admission procedures and other details.
- Internship program for students of Class 12, in collaboration with AMNS India Ltd provided students an
 opportunity to put into practice the skills learnt at school and get real work experience under the able
 mentorship and guidance by the department of Procurement and Production, Marketing and Human Resources
 Management, Information Technology and Corporate Communication, Finance and Accounts, Corporate Law,
