Academic Achievements

With a great sense of pride we would like to announce that EIS students have attained 100% qualitative results in both class 12 and class 10 CBSE examinations for the year 2018-19

The class 12 students have done us proud with their superlative performance in both the streams of Science and Commerce.

Top rankers of Class 12

In the Science stream, Ayush Kumar Gupta secured the highest score of 95.8%. He was the top scorer in Chemistry with 99 marks. He was awarded a 0.1 % merit certificate from CBSE for the same.

Soumya Kaushik stood second with 95.6%. She was the subject topper in English with 97 marks and Accountancy with 96 marks.

Om Tayal and Jay Garg jointly shared the third position with 94.6%.

In the Commerce stream, the school topper was Pragya Agarwal who secured 94.2%. She was the subject topper in Accountancy with 95 marks.

Pari Agarwal stood second with a score of 92.4% and topped in Business Studies with 97 marks.

The third position was secured by Shobhit Chaturvedi with 90.2%.

2. Team EIS attained the State Futsal Soccer Championship in the under 16 boys' category. They were further awarded the Under 16 boys' National Futsal Soccer Championship.
3. Every year EIS school teams participate in the Subroto cup.
In the under 17 boys' category, our Football team bagged the 1st runner up position. These students were also the 1st runner up in Football at Khel Mahakumbh, an event that has captured the attention of every student interested and skilled in sports.
4. In the under 14 boys' category, our Football team was declared Subroto Cup district level champion. They were also the Khel Mahakumbh 1st runner up in Football and further participated at the state level.
5. Our under 17 girls' Football team was declared the Subroto District Champion. They also participated at the state level.

6. The Under 17 boys' of team EIS won the 1st position at Khel Mahakumbh Swimming championship. They were further selected to participate at the state level.
7. Under 17 and Under 14 girls' and boys' Badminton teams got first and second position respectively in Khel Mahakumbh district level competition. They also got the opportunity to participate at the state level.
8. Our Karate, Chess, Lawn tennis and Table tennis players got selected and participated at state level competitions.

Literary achievements

1. The International Competition for young Debaters (ICYD 2019) is hosted every year in alternate venues by the Cambridge Union and the Oxford Union respectively. It is the largest international competitive debating tournament for junior debaters aged 15 and under. Aarushi Wadiwala and Jahanavi Kumar made it to the Cambridge Union, UK, and represented Team India on 27 April 2019. Jahanavi Kumar was adjudged the 7th best speaker at the tournament. We feel very proud of the achievements of our speakers.
2. 'The Beamline for School Competition' is an international competition for schools around the world and is organised by CERN, the European Organization for Nuclear Research in Geneva, Switzerland.

Our school team called the 'Galactic Aurors' were students of class 12 consisting of Anika Mundhada, Harman Kaur, Mohit Kang, Sohini Dasgupta, Siddharth Yadav, Siddharth Bhatt and Shilpy Singh. They successfully submitted an experimental proposal on gaining energy from black holes using Penrose theory for the sixth CERN Beamline for School Competition 2019.

Their introductory video was selected for the collection of the best submitted video.
3. 'The Google Code to Learn Contest 2018' organised by the Indraprastha Institute of Information Technology builds a stronger foundation for Computer Science in India.

Tanish Soni was awarded a Certificate of Appreciation for being selected as a finalist in Class 5 & 6 category in the contest.
4. EPIC India Quiz Challenge is a one-of-a-kind quiz competition in which teams from schools across India compete for the crown of having the highest 'IQ' i.e. India Quotient. The show tests the contestants' India Quotient, their knowledge of the country- its culture, history, geography, current affairs, and more. Many students from our school participated in the quiz and Jahanavi

Kumar and Navanil Das of class 10 were selected for the competition. We are so proud of these young quizzers who won the quiz and brought laurels to the school.

5. Petroleum Conservation Research Association (PCRA), under the aegis of Ministry of Petroleum & Natural Gas, Govt. of India had organised PCRA Saksham National Essay writing, Painting, and Quiz competitions with an aim to raise awareness among the youth. The painting of Swara Bhandari, our student of class 5 was selected for the finals of Saksham National Painting Competition.
6. The INCA Map Quiz conducted the branch round which witnessed a very stiff competition from 27 schools across Gujarat. 300 teams participated in the branch round at Ahmedabad, Vadodara and Hazira. The EIS team of class 10 students comprising Kavya Vashi, Priyam Chhaparia and Drishti Arun got the first position. 20 students were selected from our school for National round of INCA Quiz 2019.
